



Arrogance: An attitude of superiority manifested in an overbearing manner or in presumptuous claims or assumptions.

Meet an arrogant young man.

Belshazzar takes arrogance to new heights:

- He has no respect for God.
- He worships other Gods
- He worships himself
- But what about our arrogance.

- What about the temple?

(1 Cor 3:16)

True superiority displayed

- The writing is on the wall

- Arrogance turns to fear
 - He's shaking (verse 6)
 - He's willing to hand power to anyone who can help (verse 7)
 - He needs a man with the spirit of the holy gods in him (verses 10 and 11)

- Knowledge gained
 - Belshazzar learns who Daniel is and what God is like. (verses 18 to 21)
 - But, he already knew. (verses 22 to 23)
 - Belshazzar has been weighed and found wanting. (verses 25-28)
 - The Kingly response is foolishness (verse 29)
 - Judgement
