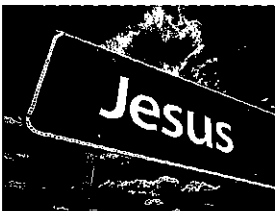

I. The King is Coming (vs.1-3)



Luke 20:41,44 *Jesus said to them, "How is it that they say the Christ is the Son of David?...David calls him 'Lord.' How then can he be his son?"*



II. The Eternal Priest-King (v.4)

► Melchize-who?

Hebrews 5:9b-10 *Jesus "became the source of eternal salvation for all who obey him and was designated by God to be high priest in the order of Melchizedek."*

Hebrews 7:24-25 *"because Jesus lives forever, he has a permanent priesthood. Therefore he is able to save completely those who come to God through him, because he always lives to intercede for them."*

III. The Warrior King (vs. 5-7)

Revelation 19:11-13a,16 *I saw heaven standing open and there before me was a white horse, whose rider is called Faithful and True. With justice he judges and makes war. His eyes are like blazing fire, and on his head are many crowns... He is dressed in a robe dipped in blood... On his robe and on his thigh he has this name, written:
KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS.*
