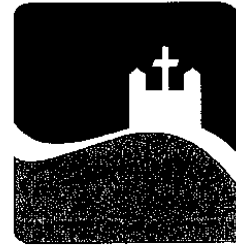

*" I saw heaven standing open and there before me was a white horse, whose rider is called Faithful and True. ... Out of his mouth comes a sharp sword with which to strike down the nations. ... On his robe and on his thigh he has this name written: KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS."* Revelation 19:11,15,16

### 1. Hallelujah chorus 19:1-8

Hallelujah = "Praise the LORD"

Because God has judged with justice and truth

God's people rejoice because his judgment expresses his

Character - righteous, holy and true

Glory

Covenant faithfulness - salvation for for his people



**Take home:** Worship is based on and responds to revealed TRUTH:

Judgement (19:1-4)

Sovereignty (19:5-8)

## **2. The return of the King in judgment 19:11-21**

One of the supreme pictures of Jesus in Scripture 19:11-16

### **The warrior Messiah 19:11-13**

1. Called faithful and true
2. Judges with justice and makes war
3. Eyes like blazing fire
4. Many crowns on his head
5. A name known only to him
6. His robe is covered in blood
7. His name is the Word of God

### **The warrior Messiah returns in judgment 19:14-21**

1. Leading the armies of heaven (white linen see verse 8)
2. The Sword of his mouth is his weapon
3. Tread the winepress of the fury of God's wrath Isaiah 63:1-6
4. Judges the nations =  
                                  he is KING OF KING AND LORD OF LORDS
5. His victory is effortless
  - his word slays his enemies
  - there is NO BATTLE !!!



**Take home:** Jesus is king of kings and Lord of Lords

Take great comfort in the sovereignty of God

**Aside: The Millennium (Thousand Years) 20:1-10**

ONLY occurs here is the Bible -> we must understand it in the  
context of the rest of the Bible NOT the reverse!!

Parallels the events of 19:11-21

1000 years is a "complete and long" period of time

My view - time between Jesus' resurrection and his return

Focus is on the Judgment of 20:11-15

**3. The books are opened 20:11-15**

Judgment is universal: all stand before the great white throne of God

Judgment is according to what we have done

The **books** of our deeds and the **book** of life:

The grace of God is our only hope - Jesus is our only saviour

Death itself is destroyed:

*"The last enemy to be destroyed is death. ...*

*Death has been swallowed up in victory"*

1 Corinthians 15:26 and 54



**Take home:**

The God of Love **IS** the Holy God of justice
